



Manchester Youth Football and Cheer 2011 Work Bond Information

Welcome to Manchester Hawks inaugural year with American Youth Football and Cheer. We are all looking forward to an amazing new season. With that said, we need the parents of the players to get involved in the day to day running of the program. It is for you, your children, you are the organization, and we are all just volunteers. Clearly, the more hands that help, the easier it is for all of us to provide outstanding programs for the kids. If we *all* work together to form a great organization, people will want to be associated with it, because it stands for many things we want in our community. We count on our members to step-up and help with fundraiser's, concessions, community days, etc to offset some of these costs. There are many jobs that need to be done in order to provide a safe and an enjoyable atmosphere, as well as enable game days to go as smoothly as possible. Some of these positions may require background checks, so you need to fill out the necessary paperwork as soon as possible if this is required.

In order to more efficiently run this organization, we have collected a work bond of \$100 per family at registration, as well as it is to be returned to those families who have satisfied their work duties at the completion of the season. At least 8 hours service is required to fulfill the \$100 work bond and YOU MUST SIGN IN AND OUT OF THE WORK LOG AT THE TIME OF SERVICE, if you don't you will not receive credit for contributed time. I will be at the field each game day with the log, as I was last year, and I will have one available to 2nd VP Tracy and the snack stand manager for those who work the snack stand. The following are just some of the jobs we need parents to help with:

Announcers Booth: read rosters, play-by-play descriptions, etc during games.

Coaches: we always welcome the help assisting (*coaching will require background checks*)

Building/Grounds Maintenance: which includes but not limited to: clean up, trash removal, vacuuming of the cheer mats, cleaning Hawks Nest, bathrooms, etc. We also are in need of electricians, plumbers, carpenters and anyone with skills or training that would benefit our field site. If you are able to assist in these areas, see board officers and separate arrangements will be made.

Field Preparation (We have complex clean up on Sat June 25 and Sat July 16 from 9am-2pm)

Chains: on the field during games

Snack Stand: Shifts are during pre-season practice from 6pm- 8:30pm and during each home game.

Game Day Duties: During each home game...ex. Bathrooms, garbage, 50/50 and any other job that needs to be done during the day.

Fund Raisers: (contact our 1st VP Cathy Famelio if you want to help with a fund raiser).

Comedy Night: (July 23)

Kick Off BBQ: (August 20)

Jersey Shore AYC Flag Mania: (Sept 17)

Please think about what you can do to help out. In the next few weeks as the season get closer, I will have further information on how to sign up.
